- 1) Failure to Compensate for All Hours Worked in Violation of NRS 608.140 and 608.016;
- 2) Failure to Pay Overtime Wages in Violation of NRS 608.140 and 608.018; and
- 3) Failure to Timely Pay All Wages Due and Owing in Violation of NRS 608.140 and 608.020-050.

JURY TRIAL DEMANDED

25 COMES NOW Plaintiff TANAH SHAFFMASTER on behalf of herself and all other
 26 similarly situated and typical persons and alleges the following:

27 All allegations in the Complaint are based upon information and belief except for those
 28 allegations that pertain to the Plaintiff named herein and her counsel. Each allegation in the

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1 Complaint either has evidentiary support or is likely to have evidentiary support after a reasonable
2 opportunity for further investigation and discovery.

3 **JURISDICTION AND VENUE**

4 1. This Court has original jurisdiction over the claims alleged herein because the
5 amount in controversy exceeds \$15,000 and a party seeking to recover unpaid wages has a private
6 right of action pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute (“NRS”) sections 608.140, 608.018, and
7 608.020-.050. *See Neville v. Eighth Judicial Dist., Terrible Herbst, Inc.*, 133 Nev. Adv. Op. 95,
8 406 P.3d 499 (2017). Plaintiff made a proper demand for wages due pursuant to NRS 608.140
9 on January 12, 2024.

10 2. Plaintiff also claims a private cause of action to foreclose a lien against the
11 property owner for wages due pursuant to NRS 608.050.

12 3. Venue is proper in the Court because the Defendant named herein maintains a
13 principal place of business or otherwise is found in the judicial district and many of the acts
14 complained of herein occurred in Elko County, Nevada, which is located within this district.

15 **PARTIES**

16 4. Plaintiff TANAH SHAFFMASTER (hereinafter “Plaintiff”) is a natural person
17 who is and was a resident of the State of Nevada at all relevant times herein.

18 5. Defendant PETCO ANIMAL SUPPLIES STORES, INC. (hereinafter
19 “Defendant” or “PETCO”) is a foreign corporation doing business in the state of Nevada and is
20 an employer under NRS 608.011 and the Nevada Constitution. Defendant’s agent of service is
21 Corporation Service Company and is located at 112 North Curry Street, Carson City, Nevada,
22 89703.

23 6. The identity of DOES 1-50 is unknown at the time and the Complaint will be
24 amended at such time when the identities are known to Plaintiff. Plaintiff is informed and believes
25 that each Defendant sued herein as DOE is responsible in some manner for the acts, omissions,
26 or representations alleged herein and any reference to “Defendant,” “Defendants,” or “PETCO”
27 herein shall mean “Defendant and each of them.”
28

1 **FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS**

2 **A. Named-Plaintiff**

3 7. Plaintiff was employed as a non-exempt hourly paid employee at Defendant's
4 retail location in Elko Nevada from on or about January 29, 2022, until on or about May 23, 2023.

5 8. At the time of her termination of employment with Defendant, Plaintiff was paid
6 on an hourly basis of approximately \$15.00 per hour, with a base overtime rate of approximately
7 \$22.50 per hour.

8 **B. Defendant's Unlawful Shift Jamming Policy**

9 9. Defendant required Plaintiff and all of its non-exempt hourly paid employees to
10 record their hours worked by clocking in/out of a timekeeping system at the retail location.

11 10. Defendant required Plaintiff and all of its non-exempt hourly paid employees to
12 clock in at the timeclock at the beginning of their work shift and to clock out at the end of their
13 work shift.

14 11. Defendant failed to compensate Plaintiff and all other similarly situated employees
15 daily overtime when they worked more than 8 hours in a workday, as defined by Nevada law.

16 12. Nevada law defines the "workday" as "a period of 24 consecutive hours which
17 begins when the employee begins work." NRS 608.0126.

18 13. Plaintiff regularly and routinely worked over 8 hours in a 24-hour period of time
19 but was not compensated daily overtime at a rate of 1.5 times her base hourly rate for her overtime
20 hours that she worked.

21 14. Upon information and belief, Defendant maintains a company-wide policy and
22 practice of refusing to pay daily overtime wages to Nevada employees who worked over 8 hours
23 in a workday.

24 15. This "no daily overtime" policy has always been common to all non-exempt hourly
25 paid employees at Defendant's locations in the state of Nevada.

26 16. As evidenced by Exhibit 1, Defendant undercompensated Plaintiff 2.22 hours
27 during her employment by failing to compensate her daily overtime wages when she worked more
28

1 than 8 hours in a 24-hour workday. She is therefore owed \$14.30 in unpaid wages and interest as
2 a result of Defendant's violations.

3 **C. Defendants' Inadequate Meal Break Policy**

4 17. Defendant also required Plaintiff and all of its non-exempt hourly paid employees
5 to clock out of the timeclock for their meal break and to clock back in at the end of their meal
6 break.

7 18. Despite requiring Plaintiff and all of its non-exempt hourly paid employees to
8 accurately record their meal periods, Defendant did not compensate Plaintiff and all of its non-
9 exempt hourly paid employees when they did not take a full 30-minute meal period. Nevada law
10 states that the continuous period of work is not interrupted (therefore wages must continue to
11 accrue and be paid) unless an employee receives a full 30-minute meal break. *See* NRS
12 608.019(1) ("No period of less than 30 minutes interrupts a continuous period of work for the
13 purposes of this subsection.").

14 19. As evidenced by Exhibit 1, Defendant undercompensated Plaintiff 1,139 minutes
15 (19 hours) during her employment by failing to compensate her wages when she did not receive
16 a full 30-minute meal break. She is therefore owed \$318.23 in unpaid wages, plus \$42.55 in
17 interest as a result of Defendant's violations.

18 20. Defendant's unlawful failure to compensate for hours worked resulting from meal
19 periods that were less than 30 minutes was a uniform practice that applied to all other similarly
20 situated employees in the same fashion as Plaintiff.

21 **CLASS ACTION ALLEGATIONS**

22 21. Plaintiff realleges and incorporates by this reference all the paragraphs above in
23 this Complaint as though fully set forth herein.

24 22. Plaintiff brings this action on behalf of herself and the following class and subclass
25 of similarly situated individuals employed by Defendant:

- 26 **A. Nevada Class:** All nonexempt hourly paid employees employed by Defendant in
27 the state of Nevada at any time within 3-years of the original filing of the complaint
28 to the present.

1 **B. Continuation Wage Subclass:** All members of the Nevada Class who are former
2 employees of Defendant.

3 23. NRCPC Rule 23 Class treatment for all claims alleged in this Complaint is
4 appropriate in this case for the following reasons:

5 A. The Class is Sufficiently Numerous: Upon information and belief,
6 Defendant employs, and has employed, in excess of 100 Class Members in each Class within the
7 applicable statute of limitations period. Because Defendant is legally obligated to keep accurate
8 payroll records, Plaintiff alleges that Defendant's records will establish the identity and
9 ascertainability of members of the Classes as well as their numerosity.

10 B. Common Questions of Law and Fact Exist: Common questions of law and
11 fact exist and predominate as to Plaintiff and the Classes, including, without limitation, the
12 following: (1) whether a meal period of less than 30 minutes interrupts the continuous period of
13 work and (2) whether Defendant failed to compensate Plaintiff and the Classes daily overtime
14 when they worked over 8 hours in a workday, as defined by Nevada law.

15 C. Plaintiff's Claims are Typical to Those of Fellow Class Members: Each
16 member of the Class and Subclass is and was subject to the same practices, plans, and/or policies
17 as Plaintiff, as follows: (1) Defendant failed to compensate Plaintiff and Class Members wages
18 when they were clocked-out for meal periods that were less than 30 minutes in duration and (2)
19 Defendant maintained the same time keeping and payroll practices so that Plaintiff and all Class
20 Members were not compensated 1.5 times their regular rate of pay when they worked over 8
21 hours in a workday. Because Plaintiff is a victim of all of the same wrongs committed by
22 Defendant as all members of the Classes that she seeks to represent, her claims are typical.

23 D. Plaintiff is an Adequate Representative of the Class and Subclass: Plaintiff
24 will fairly and adequately represent the interests of the Class and Subclass because Plaintiff is a
25 member of both, she has issues of law and fact in common with all members of the Class and
26 Subclass, and she does not have any interests antagonistic to members of the Class and Subclass.
27 Plaintiff and counsel are aware of their fiduciary responsibilities to Class Members and are
28

1 determined to discharge those duties diligently and vigorously by seeking the maximum possible
2 recovery for Class Members as a group.

3 E. Predominance/Superiority: Common questions predominate over
4 individualized issues. A class action is also superior to other available means for the fair and
5 efficient adjudication of this controversy because individual joinder of all members of the Classes
6 is impractical. Class action treatment will permit a large number of similarly situated persons to
7 prosecute their common claims in a single forum simultaneously, efficiently, and without
8 unnecessary duplication of effort and expense. Furthermore, the expenses and burden of
9 individualized litigation would make it difficult or impossible for individual members of the Class
10 to redress the wrongs done to them, while an important public interest will be served by
11 addressing the matter as a class action. Individualized litigation would also present the potential
12 for inconsistent or contradictory judgments.

13 **FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION**

14 **Failure to Pay Wages for All Hours Worked in Violation of NRS 608.140 and 608.016**

15 (On Behalf of Plaintiff and Members of the Nevada Class Against Defendant)

16 24. Plaintiff realleges and incorporates by reference all the paragraphs above in this
17 Complaint as though fully set forth herein.

18 25. NRS 608.140 provides that an employee has a private right of action for unpaid
19 wages.

20 26. NRS 608.016, entitled, "Payment for each hour of work; trial or break-in period
21 not excepted" states that: "an employer shall pay to the employee wages for each hour the
22 employee works. An employer shall not require an employee to work without wages during a
23 trial or break-in period."

24 27. Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC") 608.115(1), entitled, "Payment for time
25 worked. (NRS 607.160, 608.016, 608.250)" states: "An employer shall pay an employee for all
26 time worked by the employee at the direction of the employer, including time worked by the
27 employee that is outside the scheduled hours of work of the employee."
28

1 39. NRS 608.020 provides that “[w]henver an employer discharges an employee, the
2 wages and compensation earned and unpaid at the time of such discharge shall become due and
3 payable immediately.”

4 40. NRS 608.040(1)(a-b), in relevant part, impose a penalty on an employer who fails
5 to pay a discharged or quitting employee: “Within 3 days after the wages or compensation of a
6 discharged employee becomes due; or ... [o]n the day the wages or compensation is due to an
7 employee who resigns or quits, the wages or compensation of the employee continues at the same
8 rate from the day the employee resigned, quit, or was discharged until paid or for 30 days,
9 whichever is less.”

10 41. NRS 608.050 grants an “employee lien” to each discharged or laid-off employee
11 for the purpose of collecting the wages or compensation owed to them “in the sum agreed upon
12 in the contract of employment for each day the employer is in default, until the employee is paid
13 in full, without rendering any service therefor; but the employee shall cease to draw such wages
14 or salary 30 days after such default.”

15 42. By failing to pay members of the Continuation Wage Subclass their applicable
16 wages as described above, Defendant has failed to pay members of the Continuation Wage
17 Subclass all their wages due and owing at the time of their separation from employment.

18 43. Despite demand, Defendant willfully refuses and continues to refuse to pay all
19 members of the Continuation Wage Subclass who are former employees their full wages due and
20 owing to them upon the termination of their employment.

21 44. There is no good-faith defense to the imposition of continuation wages under NRS
22 608.040-.050. *See D’Amore v. Caesars Enterprise Svcs, LLC, et al.*, Case No. 2:18-cv-01990-
23 JCM, 2019 WL 8128166 (D. Nev. Dec. 16, 2019).

24 45. Wherefore, Plaintiff demands thirty (30) days’ wages under NRS 608.140 and
25 608.040, and an additional thirty (30) days’ wages under NRS 608.140 and 608.050, for all
26 members of the Continuation Wage Subclass during the relevant time period alleged herein,
27 together with attorneys’ fees, costs, and interest as provided by law.
28

1 **JURY TRIAL DEMANDED**

2 Plaintiff hereby demands a jury trial pursuant to Nevada Rule of Civil Procedure 38.

3 **PRAYER FOR RELIEF**

4 Wherefore Plaintiff, by herself and on behalf of all members of the Class and Subclass,
5 prays for relief as follows relating to her class action allegations:

- 6 1. For an order certifying the Class and Subclass under Nevada Rule of Civil
7 Procedure 23;
- 8 2. For an order appointing Plaintiff as the Representative of the Class and Subclass
9 and her counsel as Class Counsel;
- 10 3. For damages according to proof for regular rate pay under NRS 608.140 and
11 608.016 for all hours worked;
- 12 4. For damages according to proof for overtime compensation under NRS 608.140
13 and 608.018 for all hours worked for those employees who earned a regular rate
14 of less than one and one-half times the minimum wage for hours worked in excess
15 of 8 hours per day and/or for all class members for overtime premium pay of one
16 and one half times their regular rate for all hours worked in excess of 40 hours per
17 week;
- 18 5. For continuation wages pursuant to NRS 608.140 and 608.040-.050;
- 19 6. For a lien on the property where Plaintiff and all members of the Nevada Classes
20 labored pursuant to NRS 608.050;
- 21 7. For interest as provided by law at the maximum legal rate;
- 22 8. For reasonable attorneys' fees authorized by statute;
- 23 9. For costs of suit incurred herein;
- 24 10. For pre-judgment and post-judgment interest, as provided by law, and
- 25 11. For such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.

26 **AFFIRMATION**

27 *The undersigned does hereby affirm that the preceding document does not contain*
